3- When working on a project, the committee will seek professional advice, research facts, ask for Member comments, follow CCR, By Laws, Resolutions and all applicable state & City, County Laws. etc. This procedure will be done both to minimize "opinion" verses facts and provide a recommendation (s) which benefit the majority of Members.
