

Commons Etiquette Resolution Regarding the Use of the Commons

*“To promote a safe & enjoyable experience for all,
respect the natural environment, equipment, and the
rights and property of others”*

1. When visiting the Commons, please respect the rights and property of other Members.
2. For safety, children under the age of 12 need to be accompanied by an adult when around the Pond. *
3. For sanitation and safety, all dogs must be on a leash and owner must clean up after pet. *
4. Please respect the natural wildlife in the Pond by not disturbing them. Dogs should not be allowed to swim in the Pond. Introducing animals or fish, such as goldfish is prohibited since it will adversely affect the environment.
5. No vehicles, motorized equipment, motorbikes or ATVs may be driven onto the Commons, without prior Board approval. *
6. When leaving the Commons, please leave the area clean and orderly. Take out what you bring in including balls, clothing, picnic supplies, and all garbage.
7. To ensure safety at all times, enjoy the playground equipment within its intended purpose.
8. The rocks around the Bridge, the waterfall and the planting area are for viewing enjoyment and not open to access.
9. The Pond is not open for swimming or wading. *
10. The AHHA Commons is private property intended for the sole use of AHHA Members and their invited guests.*
11. When sharing the Commons with guests, please ensure they follow the Commons Etiquette.
12. When planning a large group gathering, please remember to submit a Commons Special Use form to the Board.
